Architectural Salvage

- By using salvaged plumbing fixtures, such as sink basins, bath tubs, and shower surrounds, we can reduce the impacts of manufacturing new goods, as well as reduce the amount of landfills material.
- Salvaged cabinets can be reconfigured, refinished, and reused to save material.
- Older, high-flow toilets should not be reused.
- Ensure that older sinks can be fitted with new aerator faucets to control water flow.
- Be sure to treat any salvaged products that may contain lead paint, mold, or other toxins accordingly.
- Thoroughly vacuum and clean any salvaged item outside the home before bringing it into the living space.
