**OCTOBER 3 – “I BOUGHT AN OLD HOUSE, NOW WHAT?”**

The time and energy you invest in research and planning in the beginning of your restoration project will save you money and help insure the results you want. Brian Davis, the Director of GHF’s Preservation and Conservation Services Department, will discuss what questions you should ask your contractor, how to develop a scope of work and get bids, and the application process for city commissions.

**OCTOBER 10 – HOW TO REPAIR YOUR HISTORIC SHUTTERS AND WINDOWS**

Long time Island craftsman Kerry Thomas, of Old World Craftsman, will share his many years of experience by teaching this class on how to maintain and repair your historic shutters and windows.

**OCTOBER 24 – HOW TO CLEAN AND MAINTAIN CEMETERY MONUMENTS**

GHF’s Matt Farragher will teach this class on how to properly clean headstones and monuments without damaging them or using harsh materials. This class would be valuable for individuals and church groups that maintain cemeteries or overall enthusiasts. The class will also include a short tour of Galveston’s historic Broadway Cemetery complex.
