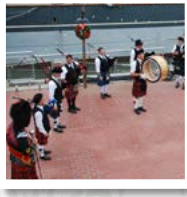

Learn about the history of The Strand and enjoy some of Saint Arnold Brewing Company's signature ales during these daily tours. Held daily. \$35 per person.



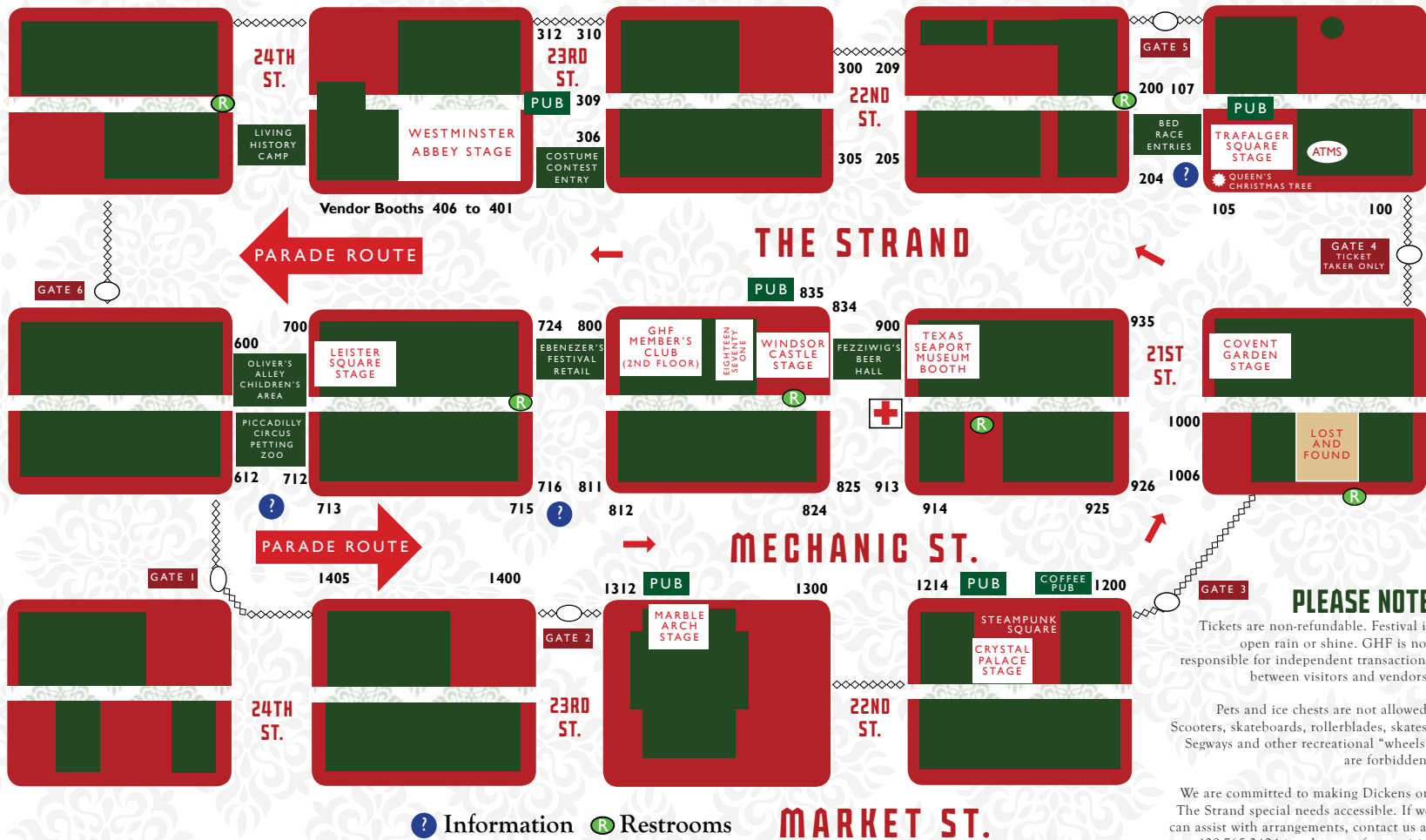
